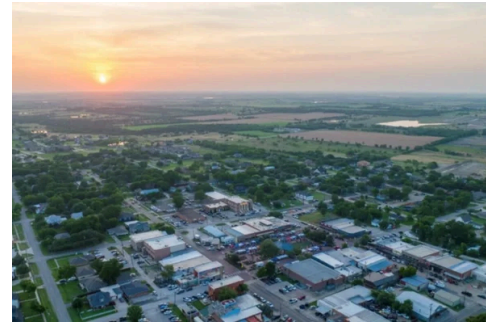


Dallas City Council Approves Zoning Request, Opening the Way to the First H-E-B store in the City Limits
