Notify important contacts and update mailing addresses early.

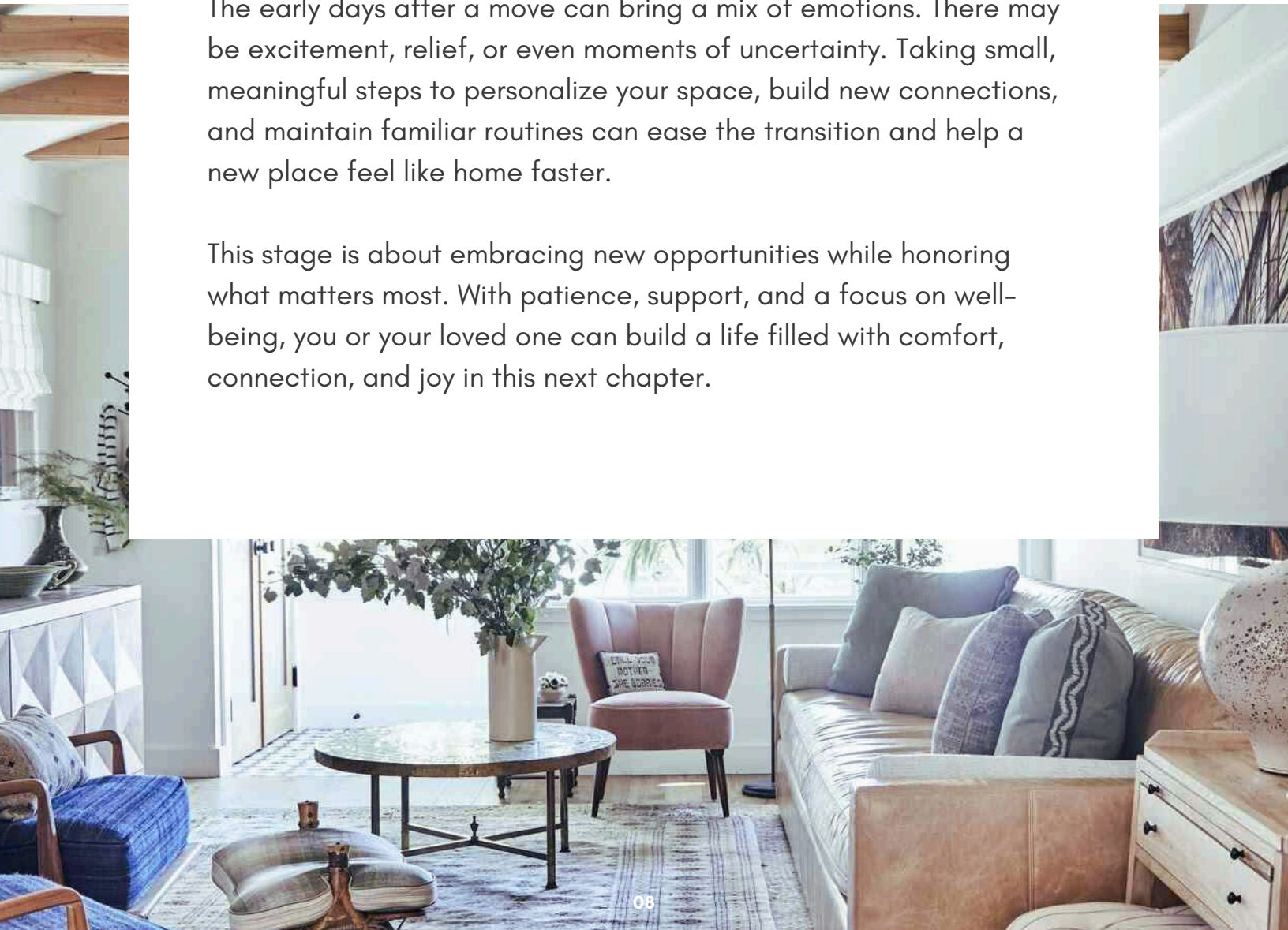

The First Steps to Feeling at Home

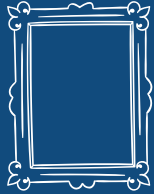
